

Learning Support Flow Chart

Please note, parents should be informed and made aware of any concerns and what support/systems are in place.

Stage 1: Initial identification + data collection

- What are your concerns for the student?
- What evidence do you have?
- What strategies/adaptations can you try to accommodate the student's needs? <u>TKI ALL Guides</u>

Stage 2: Team collaboration - Awhina Doc

- Discuss the student with your team.
- Add child's name to the Awhina document.
- As a team, brainstorm strategies together.

Stage 3: Discussion/refer to SENCO

- Refer the student to the SENCO using the Referral Form.
- Share data with the SENCO
- Enter data/concern to HERO Learning support tab.

Stage 4: School based Support

- What school based support programmes can be put in place and / or what further data can be gathered. Eg: GL screening, observation summary survey etc...
- Tiered Support TKI

Stage 5: Family consultation/collaboration

 Meet with parents/guardians to discuss the plan for their child.

Stage 6: Specialist assessment and support

SENCO will consult agencies outside of the school.
Information is shared, action plans are formulated and interventions are carried out. Agencies could include - MOE, RTLB, RTLit, Ed Psychologist, paediatricians, vision + hearing etc...
