**Flippaball** – Played all throughout the year. This is open for years 3-6 to play. Flippaball is a primary school sport based on Waterpolo. Practices will be dependent on teams, but they generally happen fortnightly on a Saturday afternoon. Games are played on Sunday afternoons at the Millennium Institute.

A coach and a team manager will be required for each team.

**Miniball** – Played all throughout the year .This is mini basketball and is open for years 1-6 to play. Games are played at the following venues. Trials are required for Yr 5-6 Children.

## Interschool Sport

**Inter school Swimming Team** – This team is selected from race times taken during our Senior Swim sports day under the discretion of our sports coordinator. We are eligible to take a maximum of 32 swimmers to this event held at The Glenn Owen Aquatic Centre in late March. This event is run by NSSC and over 20 other schools compete together over one day. The team is made up of predominantly Year 5/6 children. However, we are open to taking year 4 students who have strong swim times.

**Rippa Rugby** – This is a 3 day tournament played at Windsor Park fields across Terms 2 and 3. The game is an adaptation of rugby with a rip tag system instead of tackle. On each day of competition the teams play three 20 minute games. The first game begins at 9.30am and last game is at 1:40pm. This tournament is open to Years 3-6 and is played in bare feet. The children walk from school to the venue and back.

**Qualifying Regional Rippa Rugby Tournament** – This tournament is a mixed Year 5/6 team tournament made up of 5 boys and 5 girls played at Windsor Park. The team is chosen by trials. If this team places top after competition day they are flown to Wellington for the National finals.

**Football Cluster Day** – Year 5/6 children are eligible to trial for this half day competition played in late May Term 2 at Sunnynook school. One boys team and one girls team.

**Netball Field Day** – This is a one off round robin competition played at the AMI courts at Onewa. We usually enter our school winter year 6 netball teams. Due to the composition of our netball teams which vary each year due to numbers of children interested in playing this sport sometimes we have year 5 's involved as well.

**Basketball Cluster Day** – Year 6 children are eligible to trial for our one mixed team. This half day competition is played at the end of term 2 at the Breakers venue in Atlas Pl.

**Cross Country Cluster Team** – Our school cross country team is chosen from the top 6 placings in each age group of Year 4-6 boys and girls at our annual school cross country day. (NB Sometimes due to absence on our event day, children are placed in this team based on their outstanding training prior to the event). The Interschool team race at Sunnynook Park in mid September from 12:30 - 2.30pm.

**Super Cross Country Team** – The super cross country competition involves approximately nine local primary schools and the event is run at Rosedale Park. The team will be made up from the top 4 boys and girls in each age group from Year 4-6. Selection will be made from the children's performances at both our school and the Cluster cross country events under the discretion of our sports coordinators.

**Cluster Athletics Team** – This team is selected from their performance in our schools athletic day under the discretion of the sports coordinator in consultation with the senior team teachers. The team is made up of six boys and six girls from each age group 8, 9, 10 and 11 year olds. The November competition runs the whole day at Sovereign Stadium. All children compete in 4 disciplines softball throw, discus, long jump and high jump. Also individuals are selected for age group sprints, 200m and relay teams.
