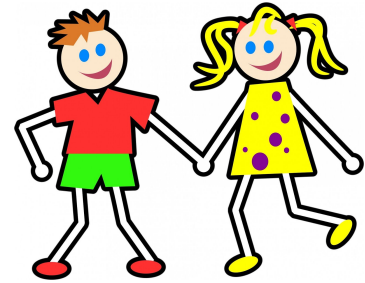

Tracking Books

General Information
