Summer Showcase

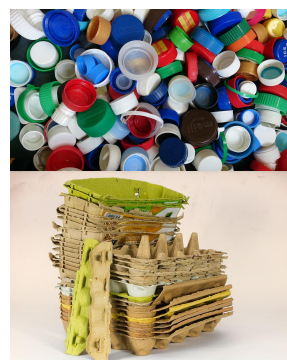
At the end of every year the Junior School put together a show for parents to come and watch. Each class will share a dance, song or performance. We will be communicating with you closer to the time about each class's costume.
